This free checklist is designed for classrooms and families. Use it to make sure you've covered the basics of fire safety and start conversations with children and staff.

- Test smoke alarms once a month.
- Make sure fire extinguishers and fire sachets are easy to access.
- Show children the sound of the fire alarm and explain what it means.
- Plan and practice an escape route from your classroom or home.
- Teach children to stay low under smoke during a fire.
- Remind everyone: never use lifts during a fire.
- Practice 'Stop, Drop, and Roll' in case clothes catch fire.
- Keep exits, hallways, and doorways clear of clutter.
- Remind children never to play with matches or lighters.
- Ensure emergency numbers (999 in the UK) are known by staff and older pupils.
